## **SECTION - 1**

### **Vision, Mission, Objectives and Functions**

**Vision:**

To be the best and most innovative National Statistical System in the world; and to effectively monitor the programmes and projects for ensuring efficient use of national resources

**Mission :**

- (i) To make available reliable and timely statistics and to undertake regular assessment of data needs for informed decision making;
- (ii) To cater to the emerging data needs in a dynamic socio-economic context, to reduce respondent burden and to avoid unnecessary duplication in data collection and publication;
- (iii) To adopt and evolve standards and methodologies for statistics generated by various elements of the National Statistical System and to steer its development for further improvement and bridging data gaps;
- (iv) To ensure and strengthen trust and confidence of all stake holders in the National Statistical System by maintaining confidentiality of data providers and promoting integrity and impartiality of all elements of official statistics ;
- (v) To provide leadership and coordination to ensure harmonious, efficient and integrated functioning of all the elements of the National Statistical System;
- (vi) To continue to assess skill requirement, and develop human resource capacity at all levels of the statistical system;
- (vii) To participate and contribute actively in all international initiatives and to support development of Statistical Systems around the world ;
- (viii) To facilitate and monitor infrastructure and large central projects to achieve high performance levels through systems improvement, and adoption of best practices; and
- (ix) To facilitate and monitor the implementation of Member of Parliament Local Area Development Scheme (MPLADS), Twenty Point Programme and other programmes and schemes for socio-economic development of the country.

### **Objectives:**

#### **a. National Statistical Organization**

- (i) To make available data/statistics on some key parameters to Planners and Policy makers in Government and outside;
- (ii) To improve the quality and reliability of existing data sets ;
- (iii) To make available new data sets on emerging fields to meet the demand of policy makers and planners ;
- (iv) To reduce time lag in bringing out Statistics ;

#### **b. Programme Implementation Wing**

- (v) To implement and monitor the Member of Parliament Local Area Development Scheme (MPLADS);
- (vi) To monitor central projects of Rs. 20 crores and above, and release regular reports;
- (vii) To monitor the performance of Infrastructure Sectors, and release regular reports; and
- (viii) To monitor the Twenty Point Programme, and release regular reports

### **Functions:**

The Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation is the nodal agency for planning and facilitating the integrated development of the statistical system in the country, and to lay down norms & standards in the field of official statistics, evolving concepts, definitions, classification and methodologies of data collection, processing and release of results, etc. The Ministry is also responsible for monitoring and evaluation of major projects and programmes of the Government, besides implementing Member of Local Area Development Scheme (MPLADS).

**SECTION - 4**

**Description and Definition of Success Indicators and Proposed Measurement Methodology**

**1. Estimation of National Income:** The national accounts provide a comprehensive, conceptual, and accounting framework for analysing and evaluating the performance of an economy. As the national accounts are designed to account for all economic transactions, their compilation is a major exercise drawing information from several diverse data source, and adopting different approaches like expenditure approach, income approach and production approach.

**2. Index of Industrial Production (IIP):** Index of Industrial Production (IIP) represents the status of production in the industrial sector for a given period of time as compared to a reference period of time. The current series of the IIP is having Base 1993-94, and covers 543 items in three sectors viz. Mining (64), Manufacturing (478) and Electricity (1) as against 350 items in the earlier series with base 1980-81. The index is a simple weighted arithmetic mean of production relatives calculated by using Laspeyre's formula.

**3. Annual Survey of Industries (ASI):** The Annual Survey of Industries (ASI) is the principal source of industrial statistics in India. It provides statistical information to assess and evaluate the changes in the growth, composition and structure of organised manufacturing sector comprising activities related to manufacturing, repair services, gas and water supply and cold storage. The ASI frame is based on the lists of registered factories/units maintained by the Chief Inspector of Factories (CIF) in each State/UT and those maintained by licensing authorities in respect of bidi and cigar establishments and electricity undertakings.

**4. Crop Cutting Experiments:** The Field Operation Division of the National Sample Survey Office (NSSO) conducts crop cutting experiments to generate yield estimates of major crops. Stratified multi stage random sampling design is adopted for carrying out these surveys with tehsil, taluks etc. as strata, revenue village within a strata as first stage unit of sampling, survey numbers/fields within each selected village as sampling unit at the second stage and an experimental plot of a specified shape and size as the ultimate unit of sample.

**5. Sample Check on Area Enumeration:** The estimation of areas statistics is made by the National Sample Survey Office with the co-operation for the States /UTs. The prime objective is

to generate timely and reliable estimates of area under principal crops for each of the agricultural seasons.

**6. NSS Socio-Economic Surveys:** The National Sample Survey Office conducts nationwide sample surveys on various socio-economic issues in successive rounds, each round covering subjects of current interest in a specific survey period. The period of survey is of one year duration, starting on 1st July and ending on 30th June. The survey period of each round is divided into four sub-rounds of three months' duration. In each of these four sub-rounds, equal numbers of sample villages/ blocks are allotted for survey with a view to ensuring uniform spread of sample over the entire survey period. A stratified multi-stage design has been adopted for the surveys.

**7. Non-Profit Institution (NPI) Surveys:** The primary objective of Non-Profit Institution Surveys is to generate separate accounts for the NPI sector in terms of employment and output in the national accounts statistics. This survey has been planned to be conducted in two phases with the collaboration with State Governments/UTs. In the first phase, the manual records on NPIs available with their registering authorities in different States of the country have to be computerized so that the frame of the registered NPIs in the country is available at one place. In the second phase, all the listed NPIs are to be visited by investigators to physically verify their existence and simultaneously collect employment and financial data from the functioning NPIs.

**8. Consumer Price Index (CPI) Numbers:** The Central Statistical Office is in the process of compiling of new series of CPI for Urban, Rural and Combined, at State/UT/All India level, covering the entire population. The CPI (Urban) would be compiled for each State/UT as well as at All India level. All cities/towns having population (2001 Population Census) more than 9 lakh, and all State/UT capitals not covered therein were selected purposively. In all 310 towns have been selected either on purposive or random basis from which 1114 quotations (price schedules) are canvassed every month. Regular price and rent data are being collected by the NSSO (FOD). After selection of base year and also compilation of base year prices, new series of CPI (Urban) would be compiled. The CPI (Rural) would be compiled for all States/UTs and for All India. A total of 1183 villages have been selected at all India level. The broad criterion of selection of villages is to have representation of all the districts with in State/UT and therefore two villages from each district adjusted on the basis of rural population of the State/UT have been selected randomly from different tehsils. The price data collection for the compilation of Index is under progress.

**9. Monitoring of MPLAD Scheme:** For effective implementation of the works taken up under this scheme, each State Government/UT Administration has designated one nodal Department for

physical monitoring through field inspection and for coordination with the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation. The Heads of Districts are required to visit and inspect at least 10% of these works every year. Similarly, it is the responsibility of the senior officers of implementing agencies of these works to regularly visit the work spots and ensure that the works are progressing satisfactorily as per the prescribed procedures and specifications. Likewise, officers of district at the sub-divisional and block level are also closely monitoring implementation of these works through visits to work sites. A schedule of inspections which prescribes the minimum number of field visits for each supervisory level functionary of the implementing agencies is to be drawn up by MOSPI. A software for monitoring MPLADS works, in which provision has been made for the district authorities to upload the details of works, so as to enable universal online access with a view to facilitate increase in transparency, accountability and promote e-governance, has been launched from November, 2004. The District Authorities are responsible to upload the data of works in the software, which is monitored by the Ministry. The Ministry has also embarked on a radical monitoring initiative, by initiating direct physical monitoring of MPLADS works on a sample basis in various districts of the country, by an independent institution, viz. the NABARD Consultancy Services (NABCONS).

**10. Monitoring of Projects :**The Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation monitors the performance of the country's eleven key infrastructure sectors, viz., Power, Coal, Steel, Railways, Telecommunications, Ports, Fertilizers, Cement, Petroleum & Natural Gas, Roads and Civil Aviation with the special focus on removing the bottlenecks in the way of their accelerated growth. A monthly review Report of Infrastructure Performance and Capsule Report on Infrastructure Performance is brought out as a part of the monitoring of infrastructure sectors based on the information received from concerned Ministries/Departments. In addition, the Ministry monitors all Central Sectors projects of the Government costing Rs.20 crores and above on a quarterly basis. Similarly, major projects costing Rs.100 crore and above are monitored on a monthly basis through a system of Flash Reports. These projects are monitored against the milestones set at the commencement of the projects.

**11. Monitoring of 20-Point Programme:** The Twenty Point Programme (TPP)-2006, a package of social sector schemes and programmes, consists of 20 points and 66 items being administered by various Ministries of Government of India and implemented by States/UTs. The primary responsibility of implementation and monitoring of the programmes lies with the agencies entrusted with the execution of the programme i.e., the States Governments/UT Administrations and Central Nodal Ministries. The MOSPI monitors the programme in totality. With a view to monitor the Programmes more effectively, monitoring committees has been set up by States/UTs Governments

at Block level in addition to existing Committees at District and State level. At the Centre, progress of various Schemes/Programmes covered under TPP is monitored by the Central nodal Ministries concerned. At the State level, the concerned nodal Department, mostly Planning Department, monitors the Programme. The MOSPI brings out Monthly Progress Report (MPR) indicating achievements for monthly monitored items on the basis of information received from States/UTs and central nodal Ministries.
