Method followed by CSB for posting of newly recruited Junior Statistical Officers (JSOs) of Subordinate Statistical Service (SSS) selected through CGLE, 2016

1. The following parameters have been kept in view by the Civil Service Board (CSB) while recommending the initial posting of the newly recruited JSOs of SSS:

- (a) In the first instance the newly recruited PWD (PH) candidates were allocated the State/Office(s) as per their *inter-se* seniority near to their native place(s)/preferred choice of posting.
- (b) Thereafter, for the remaining candidates, going strictly by the rank of the candidates:
 - (i). First preferred State was allocated to the candidate, subject to the availability of vacant post of JSO in the concerned State;
 - (ii). In case no vacant post of JSO was available in the first preferred State of the candidate, second preferred State was allocated to him;
 - (iii). and so on.
- (c) In case where no vacant post of JSO was available in any of the preferred States of the candidate, he/she was posted to the geographically nearest State to his first preferred State where a vacant post of JSO is available.
- (d) While posting JSOs to their preferred States, linguistic compatibility of the candidates with the allocated State to the extent possible was also considered.
- (e) Within a State the posting of JSOs was carried out in the order of office code in the alphabetical order.
- (f) The candidates were allocated to the State(s)/office(s), based on their merit-preference on the *pro-rata* basis of the vacancies available in the State concerned.
- (g) The posting details of the newly recruited JSOs, nominated by CGLE-2016, are at Annexure -A.

2. This, in no manner, should be construed as an Offer of Appointment and is for the purpose of information of candidates only. The Offer of Appointment will be issued after thorough verification of the candidature by this Ministry. Further, if at any stage, any declaration given or information furnished by the candidate is proved to be false; or found to have willfully suppressed any material information; or it is found that the candidate do not possess the required eligibility, she/he will be liable for cancellation of candidature/removal from service/such other action, as Government may deem necessary.

3. The digitally signed purely provisional 'Offer of Appointment' will be issued by this Ministry through e-mail and not by post which would be subject to verification. The candidates should take the original certificates, etc. as mentioned in Offer of Appointment and report to the address mentioned therein.

4. The candidates who have submitted their willingness to this Ministry through e-mail, however, they have not submitted their willingness and requisite documents to this Ministry by post. The Offer of Appointment to these candidates will be issued only after submission of the requisite documents to this Ministry as mentioned at Annexure -B. Further, no reply has been received till date from the candidates as mentioned at Annexure -C. The candidates mentioned at Annexure -B and Annexure -C are given a final opportunity to submit their willingness through e-mail and by Post latest by 27.04.2018 positively failing which it would be deemed that they are not willing to join the Service and their candidature shall be liable to be cancelled without giving any further notice.
