Major initiatives and achievements of the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation during April, 2022

The National Statistical Office (NSO) released Price Movement of Sub-Groups/Groups of Consumer Price Index (CPI) on **Base 2012=100** for All India Rural, Urban, Combined for the month of **April 2022 (Provisional)** and for the month of **March 2022 (Final)** on 12th May, 2022. The General Consumer Price Indices (CPI) for the month of **April 2022 (Provisional)** for Rural, Urban and Combined were 170.8, 169.2 and 170.1, showing an annual inflation rate of 8.38%, 7.09% and 7.79% respectively. The corresponding inflation rates (Final) for Rural, Urban and Combined for **March 2022** were 7.66%, 6.12% and 6.95% respectively.

- 2. All-India Consumer Food Price Index (CFPI) for the month of **April 2022** (**Provisional**) for Rural, Urban and Combined were 167.2, 173.6 and 169.5 respectively. All India year-on-year inflation rates for CFPI for themonth of **April 2022** (**Provisional**) for Rural, Urban and Combined sector were 8.50%, 8.09% and 8.38% respectively. The corresponding inflation rates (Final) for Rural, Urban and Combined for **March 2022** were 8.04%, 7.04% and 7.68% respectively.
- 3. The All-India Index of Industrial Production (IIP) for the month of **March 2022** (Quick Estimates) with the base year 2011-12 has been released on 12th May 2022 and it stood at 148.3.
- 4. During the month of April 2022, Ministry has released following Press Note/Document:
 - (i) Press Note on Payroll Reporting in India: An Employment Perspective February 2022.
 - (ii) Document on Environment Accounting "EnviStats India Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)" with the aim to help the users to have a better understanding on the natural capital accounting as well as access to the answers of specific queries pertaining to Environment Accounting at a single platform.
- 5. The major highlights of Central Sector Projects monitored under Online Computerized Monitoring System (OCMS) by this Ministry for the month of **April 2022** are as under:

6. As per the latest Review Report on the Performance of the Infrastructure Sectors up to the month of March 2022, Power Generation (+10.02%), Coal Production (+2.54%)

Refinery Production (+0.97%), Railways (+0.94%), Import Cargo handled at Airports (+23.19%), Passenger traffic handled at International terminal of the Airports (+47.21%) and Passenger Traffic handled at Domestic terminal of the Airports (+2.79%) exceeded its targets.

7. The Sectors that fell short of their targets are Fertilizers Production (-15.90%), Crude Oil Production (-11.67%), Natural Gas Production (-9.65%), Upgradation of Highways by NHAI (-3.87%), Upgradation of Highways by State PWD & Border Road Organization (BRO) (-13.12%), and Export Cargo handled at Airports (-0.63%).
