Major initiatives and achievements of the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation during July 2020

The National Statistical Office (NSO) has released Price Movement of Sub-Groups/Groups of Consumer Price Index (CPI) on **Base 2012=100** for All India Rural, Urban, Combined for the month of June, 2020 (Provisional) on 13th July, 2020.

- 2 The Index of Industrial Production (IIP) for the month of May, 2020 was also released by NSO on 10th July, 2020. The IIP for the month of May, 2020 stood at 88.4.
- 2.1 As the various pandemic related restrictions were gradually lifted and most of the activities started resuming operations, NSO compiled all India price indices by considering a common market at the national level, in Rural & Urban sectors separately. The General Consumer Price Indices (CPI) for the month of **June**, **2020** (Provisional) for Rural, Urban and Combined were 152.5, 150.5 and 151.6, showing an annual inflation rate of 6.20%, 5.91% and 6.09% respectively.
- 2.2 The All-India Consumer Food Price Index (CFPI) for the month of **June**, **2020** for Rural, Urban and Combined are 150.9, 154.5 and 152.2 respectively. All India year-on-year inflation rates for CFPI for the month of **June**, **2020** for Rural, Urban and Combined sector are 8.41%, 6.92% and 7.87% respectively. The corresponding inflation rates (Final) for Rural, Urban and Combined for **May**, **2020** were 9.68%, 8.29% and 9.20% respectively.
- 3 The fieldwork of 7th Economic Census (EC) was also accelerated across 34 States/ UTs during the month with the lifting of lockdown related restrictions. Consultations with State governments towards 7th EC data finalisation as well as progress review were initiated during the month. First webinar with Mizoram, Nagaland and Tripura was held on 30th July, 2020 for finalisation of results.
- 4. Highlights of status of the infrastructure sector are the following:
- 4.1 The latest Flash Report for the ongoing Central Sector Projects costing Rs.150 crore and above of May, 2020 shows as under:

- 4.3 As per the latest Review Report on the Performance of the Infrastructure Sectors for the month of May, 2020, only Upgradation of Highways by State PWD & Border Road Organisation (BRO) (+63%) exceeded their targets.
- 4.4 The Sectors that had fallen short of their targets were Power Generation (-15.99%), Coal Production (-23.62%), Fertilizers Production (-9.83%), Crude Oil Production (-2.47%), refinery production (-22.47%) Natural Gas Production (-11.11%), Upgradation of Highways by NHAI (-8.29%), Export Cargo handled at Airports (-5.16%), Import Cargo handled at Airports (-0.57%), Passenger traffic handled at International terminals of the Airports (-37.16%) and Passenger traffic handled at Domestic terminals of the Airports (-56.25%).
