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Background Note on TPP

Introduction

The Twenty Point Programme (TPP) was launched by the Government of India in the year 1975 and was restructured in 1982, 1986 and again in 2006. The restructured programme, known as Twenty Point Programme (TPP) – 2006, became operational with effect from 1st April 2007. The programme is meant to give a thrust to schemes relating to poverty alleviation, employment generation in rural areas, housing, education, family welfare & health, protection of environment and many other schemes having a bearing on the quality of life, especially in the rural areas.

Central Monitoring of TPP

Twenty Point Programme (TPP) – 2006 consists of 20 Points and 65 items (**Annexure -1**) being monitored individually by Central Nodal Ministries concerned. The Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation (MOSPI) monitors holistically the programme/ schemes covered under TPP-2006 on the basis of performance reports received from State Governments and central nodal Ministries. Out of 65 items, 20 items (information in respect of 16 items is being collected from various States/ UTs and for remaining 4 items from the concerned Central Nodal Ministries) are being monitored on monthly basis during the period 2012-13 against the targets fixed at the beginning of financial year by the central nodal Ministries and State Governments (**Annexure -2**). The remaining items under TPP-2006 are being monitored on annual basis as the information in respect of these items is made available by the concerned Central Nodal Ministries only on annual basis. These 65 items consist of about 160 identified parameters. However, for the purpose of monthly performance, 19 identified parameters have been taken (**Annexure -3**).

Monitoring mechanism in States

The monitoring mechanism for TPP-2006 has been widened by including Block level monitoring in addition to District, State and central level monitoring. Most of the States/Union Territories have constituted Block, District and State level monitoring committees. At the Centre, the progress of individual items is monitored and reviewed by the Departments/Ministries concerned.

Item I: Review of State-wise performance of Programmes/Schemes covered under TPP

Twenty Point Programme-2006 having 20 points consists of 65 items/schemes which are monitored on 162 measurable parameters. Out of these 162 parameters, 34 parameters are monitored on monthly basis of which 19 parameters are monitored against preset targets. These targets are fixed by the Central Nodal Ministry in consultation with the States /UTs and Planning Commission. The Monthly progress report is compiled on the basis of data received from the Central Nodal Ministries and State Governments/UT Administrations. The data is received either through web enabled software developed by National Informatics Centre (NIC) Cell in this Ministry or through Fax/e-mail/post. The processing of data is being done in association with NIC Cell.

Schematic Analysis:

The analysis for 2011-2012 shows that the performance under **fourteen** items has been '**Very Good**' (90% or above the targets) (**Annexure – 4**). These items are:

- (i) Individual Swarozgaries assisted under SGSY
- (ii) Pump sets energised
- (iii) Seedlings planted (Public and Forest Lands)
- (iv) SC Families assisted
- (v) Urban Poor Families assisted under Seven Point Charter
- (vi) SHGs provided Income Generating Activities under SGSY
- (vii) Road constructed under Prime Minister Grameen Sadak Yojana (PMGSY)
- (viii) ICDS Blocks Operational (Cum.)
- (ix) Food Security: Targeted Public Distribution System (only for BPL)
- (x) Habitations covered (Partially covered & Slipped back)- NRDWP
- (xi) Anganwadis Functional (Cum.)
- (xii) Food Security: Targeted Public Distribution System (only for AAY)
- (xiii) Area covered under Plantation (Public and Forest Lands) and
- (xiv) Supply of Electricity

The performance in respect of **three** items/ parameters namely, 'Targeted Public Distribution System for APL, BPL & AAY', 'Houses constructed under (IAY)' and 'Coverage of water quality affected habitations – NRDWP' has been "**Good**". Further, the performance of **two** items/ parameters namely, 'Houses constructed under EWS/LIG' and 'Village electrified–(RGGVY)' has been '**Poor**' i.e. below 80% of target. The scheme wise – state wise performance for 2011-12 is at **Annexure-5**.

The analysis for the period **April - October 2012 (Annexure- 6)** shows that the performance under **fourteen** items has been '**Very Good**' (90% or above the targets). These items are:

- (i) Individual Swarozgaries assisted under SGSY
- (ii) Urban Poor Families assisted under Seven Point Charter
- (iii) Seedlings planted (Public and Forest Lands)
- (iv) ICDS Blocks Operational (Cum.)
- (v) Area covered under Plantation (Public & Forest Lands)
- (vi) Pumpsets energised
- (vii) Road constructed under Prime Minister Grameen Sadak Yojana (PMGSY)
- (viii) Houses constructed under Indira Aawas Yojana(IAY)
- (ix) Food Security: Targeted Public Distribution System only for BPL
- (x) Food Security: Targeted Public Distribution System only for AAY
- (xi) Anganwadis Functional (Cum.)
- (xii) SC Families assisted
- (xiii) Food Security: Targeted Public Distribution System for (APL+ BPL+AAY) and
- (xiv) Supply of Electricity

The performance of **five** items namely 'Villages electrified under RGGVY', 'Habitations covered (partially & Slipped Back) – NRDWP', 'Houses constructed under EWS/LIG', 'SHGs provided Income Generating Activities under SGSY', and 'Coverage of water quality affected habitations – NRDWP' has been '**Poor**' i.e. below 80% of target. The scheme wise – state wise performance for 2012-13 (upto Oct. 2012) is at **Annexure -5**.

In comparison to the performance of targetable monthly monitored parameters for 2011-12, two items have improved to very good from good, whereas three items have slipped to 'Poor' from 'Good'. A statement indicating the movement of such items is annexed (**Annexure-7**).

The performance of non-targetable monthly monitored parameters for 2012-13 (upto Oct. 2012) is not commensurate to the performance during 2011-12 as of the 15 parameters, 11 have shown reduced performance while 4 only have shown improved performance. A statement indicating the actual achievement of all 34 monthly monitored parameters and relative achievement of non-targetable parameters is annexed (**Annexure- 8**).

State wise Performance

The State wise performance during 2011-2012 as measured on 19 targetable monthly monitored items has been very good in respect of the states of Himachal Pradesh, Rajasthan, Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat, Uttarakhand and UT's of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Lakshadweep. Many other states have also performed very well barring for few schemes. The States of Arunachal Pradesh, Bihar, Punjab, Meghalaya, Jammu & Kashmir, West Bengal, Chattisgarh and UT of Daman & Diu however could not perform as expected. The State wise details of their performance on number of parameters during 2011-12 are at **Annexure-9(A)**. The scheme-wise details of each state are at **Annexure-9(B)**.

During the current year also i.e. 2012-2013 up to October 2012, the states of Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat and Karnataka have done well whereas Assam, Chhattisgarh, Nagaland, and Odisha are required to improve their performance to the expected level. The State wise detail of the performance on number of parameters during current year i.e. 2012-13 are at **Annexure- 10(A)**. Scheme wise details of each state are at **Annexure-10(B)**.

Item No.2 – Problems in implementation

(a) Reporting performance on lesser parameters

TPP 2006 consists of 65 items which are monitored on 162 parameters. Of the 65 items 20 items are monitored on monthly basis through 34 parameters. The information in respect of these parameters is obtained from the State Govt./UT Administration and Central Nodal Ministry. However it has been observed that the States are not providing information in respect of all the 34 parameters. While some of schemes may not be implemented, but there are cases where States/UT's have opted out of the central monitoring of Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation. Some of the States are not even been providing information in respect of all the 19 targeted monthly monitored parameters. During 2011-12, only six States have provided information on all the 19 targetable parameters where as some States like Goa, Delhi and the Union Territories provided information for as few as 10 to 11 parameters. A statement indicating the no. of parameters on which information is reported on monthly basis is annexed **(Annexure – 9(A) & 10(A))**. The States which reported on less number of parameter may indicate the reason for the same.

(b) Monitoring Committees in the States

The guidelines of the TPP 2006 provide for setting up of an extensive monitoring mechanism in the States. As per these guidelines States are expected to set up 4 levels of monitoring committees i.e. at State level , district level, block level and village level. Whereas all the States/Union Territories have constituted committees at State level / UT level and these are functioning by and large. However, the monitoring committee at the district and block levels are either not constituted or not functioning. A Statement indicating the status of monitoring committee in various states is annexed **(Annexure - 11)** It is felt that quite often the performance of the scheme covered under TPP is not satisfactory as the critical issues do not get adequate attention at the implementation level. The district level monitoring committee can be expected to put sufficient pressure on the implementing agencies for improving the performance of the schemes in the area. States which are yet to set up monitoring committees at district and block level may give their opinion on the difficulty of setting the same in their States.

Item No. 3 - Problems in Monitoring of TPP and other Issues

(a) Delays and Variation in reporting of monthly performance figures.

The Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation (MOSPI) monitors the Programme/schemes covered under TPP-2006 on the basis of performance report received from State/UT Governments and Central nodal Ministries. Information regarding progress made in respect of 16 items is being collected from various States/UTs and for the remaining 4 items from the concerned Central nodal Ministries. While processing the monthly data, it has been observed that there is wide variation in the data/information furnished each month by the State/UT Governments and Central Nodal Ministries. The wide variation could be assessed from the statement based on the performance figures reported by the States/UTs and Central Nodal Ministries like Ministry of Rural Development and Ministry of Power for the Period April-October, 2012 **(at Annexure- 12)**. The variation is more prominent in the schemes of MGNREGA, SGSY (2 parameters) and IAY. Among the states, the variation is huge (more than 10 times) in respect of H.P., Karnataka, M.P., Manipur, Nagaland, Rajasthan and Tripura. The Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation has been seeking clarification from Planning Secretaries of States/UTs on this issue, however the problem of variation still persist. The States/UTs are required to take proper initiative and care in providing information in consultation with the line departments of States.

2. Another area of concern is the delay in reporting of information. As per the extant guidelines, the states are to provide monthly performance information for each month by 25th of each succeeding month. However some of the States/UTs namely Arunachal Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Nagaland, Orissa, Mizoram, West Bengal, Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Central nodal Ministry of Labour & Employment are submitting the monthly progress reports much after the date specified by this Ministry. Sometimes, the information is not available till the publication of report. In such cases, the information from that State for that month is taken as zero, which places that State as poor performing State. A statement indicating such delay in reporting of monthly performance by various states is at **Annexure- 13**. The States/UTs are requested to adhere to the time schedule as specified by this Ministry i.e. by 25th of the succeeding month and furnish the information preferably through online software with a copy through e-mail.

(b) Fixation of targets, Abnormal Achievements, causes

Out of the 162 parameters, 19 parameters of TPP-06 are monitored against pre set targets. These targets are fixed by the Central nodal Ministries in consultation with the States /UTs and Planning Commission. However there is a general delay of 2-3 months in the fixation of targets by the central nodal Ministries. Consequently the status performance is seen laggard in the first few months of each year. The Central nodal Ministries have to take some steps for the early fixation of targets.

2. Targets are fixed to facilitate a measured direction of growth in the implementation of programmes. Targets are fixed also according to the funds allocation under Central Ministry's Plan (CSS) made to States/UT's without considering the capacity and need of the state or without considering State Plan/Non-plan outlays. The States have often complained about the TPP targets of some schemes being unrealistic. One common complaint is that the targets are not fixed, taking into account the ground realities/ requirements in the states. Such fixation of targets leads to erratic performance by the states. There are instances when some states have shown under performance to the extent of 10%, whereas, some states have shown performance to the extent of 1000% in some scheme.

3. It has also been observed that there is very high achievement for the parameters like SC families assisted, Individual swarojgaries assisted under SGSY and number of poor family assisted under seven point charter. It is made out that some states have lack of clarity over the scope of such parameters. There is also no clarity whether a state can show achievements against targets when such part achievements are against funds allocated under State Plan/Non Plan schemes or finance commission funds schemes. A Statement showing such abnormal achievement is annexed (**Annexure-14**).

4. In order to have a measured and orderly growth in the implementation of schemes, it is necessary that Central nodal Ministries have close coordination with the State line Department while fixing the targets. Further, it is proposed that we can have a general approach by adopting last year's performance as current year target, wherever Central nodal Ministries have not fixed the targets.

(c) Review of unit financial norms under TPP programmes/schemes

Twenty Point Programme as a socio economic developer has provisions for financial and economic assistance under various schemes. Under Indira Awas Yojna, a financial grant of Rs.45,000 to 48,500/- is provided for the construction of dwelling. Similarly there are provision of providing fixed financial assistance or subsidy under EWS/LIG under JNNURM and "Sanitation Scheme". Similarly under Old Age pension scheme/ Disability scheme etc., a monthly pension of Rs.200 has been provided.

2. States representatives have been complaining for sometime at various fora regarding the inadequacy of these unit financial norms under various schemes. Some states have mentioned that due to such abnormality, there are few takers for the Government of India schemes. It has also been mentioned that the financial norms fixed under the scheme are rarely revised during the currency of scheme and if at all there are revisions, the same have not been commensurate with the erosion in the value of money.

3 The financial norms under the scheme are fixed by the Central nodal Ministries in consultation with the Planning Commission. These norms are generally based on the availability of funds under the schemes and other related considerations. Schemes are rarely seen to be having any provision for periodic review of unit cost. Erosion in the value of money with time and regional variation in the cost of products and services are issues worthy of consideration in this meeting. The issue was discussed in the last National Review Meeting held in November, 2011 which inter-alia recommended for periodic revision or indexing of such financial norms.

4. Central Nodal Ministries and States may give their considered opinion on it.

(d) Proposals for Revamping of Twenty Point Programme

Twenty Point Programme: initiated in 1975 has been restructured thrice in 1982, 1986 and 2006. Since then there have also been some changes in the name and structure of schemes as covered under the existing TPP-2006. Further, since the last revision in 2006 a number of new initiatives towards social and infrastructure development have been taken by Government. Bharat Nirman /Flagship Programmes in the year 2005-06 was a major initiative taken in the XIth Plan. The changed scenario of the XIth plan & XIIth plan will require revamping of TPP and the outcome of the present exercise by Planning Commission will also have a bearing on TPP-2006. Considering these developments, there is a need to revamp the Twenty Point Programme-2006.

2. Under Flagship Programme, there are 13 programmes, all of which are not fully covered under the existing TPP. Further, monitoring of the covered programmes is limited to few selected parameters only. A list of Flagship Programmes and parameters being monitored is annexed **Annexure-15**). The Ministry is now actively considering to revamp the Twenty Point Programme taking into consideration the developments as mentioned above. It is for consideration of this meeting if any parameters/schemes need be dropped from monitoring and also for suggestion for including additional parameter/ scheme for monitoring.

**PERFORMANCE OF MONTHLY MONITORED PARAMETERS
DURING 2011 - 2012**
