

Major initiatives and achievements of the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation during February, 2022

The National Statistical Office (NSO), Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation released Price Movement of Sub-Groups/Groups of Consumer Price Index (CPI) on Base 2012=100 for All India Rural, Urban, Combined for the month of **February 2022 (Provisional)** and for the month of **January 2022 (Final)** on 14th March, 2022. The General Consumer Price Indices (CPI) for the month of February 2022 (Provisional) for Rural, Urban and Combined were 166.7, 165.5 and 166.1, showing an annual inflation rate of 6.38%, 5.75% and 6.07% respectively. The corresponding inflation rates (Final) for Rural, Urban and Combined for January 2022 were 6.12%, 5.91% and 6.01% respectively.

2. All-India Consumer Food Price Index (CFPI) for the month of **February 2022 (Provisional)** for Rural, Urban and Combined were 162.3, 168.8 and 164.6 respectively. All India year-on-year inflation rates for CFPI for the month of February 2022 for Rural, Urban and Combined sector were 5.87%, 5.76% and 5.85% respectively. The corresponding inflation rates (Final) for Rural, Urban and Combined for January 2022 were 5.18%, 5.88% and 5.43% respectively.

3. The All-India Index of Industrial Production (IIP) for the month of **January, 2022** (Quick Estimates) with the base year 2011-12 was released on 11th March, 2022 and it stood at 138.4.

4. During the month of February, 2022, Ministry released Press Note on Payroll Reporting in India: An Employment Perspective - December 2021, Second Advance Estimates of National Income 2021-22 and Quarterly Estimates of Gross Domestic Product for the Third Quarter (Oct-Dec), 2021-22.

5. The major highlights of Central Sector Projects monitored under Online Computerized Monitoring System (OCMS) by this Ministry for the month of **February 2022** are as under:

As per the latest Review Report on the Performance of the Infrastructure Sectors up to the month of January 2021, Power Generation (+8.51%), Import Cargo handled at Airports (+20.85%), Passenger traffic handled at International terminal of the Airports (+52.60%) and Passenger traffic handled at Domestic terminal of the Airports (+4.75%) **exceeded** its targets.

7. The Sectors that fell short of their targets are Coal Production (-10.98%), Fertilizers Production (-16.43%), Crude Oil Production (-4.63%), Refinery Production (-1.24%), Natural Gas Production (-9.59%), Upgradation of Highways by NHAI (-24.23%), Upgradation of Highways by State PWD & Border Road Organization (BRO) (-21.30%), Railways (-1.48%) and Export Cargo handled at Airports (-2.50%).
