



## Major initiatives and achievements of the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation during February, 2021

1. The National Statistical Office (NSO) released Price Movement of Sub-Groups / Groups of Consumer Price Index (CPI) on **Base 2012=100** for All India Rural, Urban, Combined for the month of February 2021 (Provisional) and for the month of January, 2021 (Final) on 12<sup>th</sup> March, 2021. Price data are collected from selected 1114 urban markets and 1181 villages by the Field Operations Division of NSO, MoSPI in a uniform weekly roaster.
2. The General Consumer Price Indices (CPI) for the month of **February, 2021** (Provisional) for Rural, Urban and Combined were 156.7, 156.5 and 156.6, showing an annual inflation rate of 4.19%, 5.96% and 5.03% respectively. The corresponding inflation rates (Final) for Rural, Urban and Combined for **January, 2021** were 3.23%, 5.13% and 4.06% respectively.
3. All-India Consumer Food Price Index (CFPI) for the month of **February 2021** (Provisional) for Rural, Urban and Combined were 153.3, 159.6 and 155.5 respectively. All India year-on-year inflation rates for CFPI for the month of **February, 2021** for Rural, Urban and Combined sector were 2.89%, 5.63% and 3.87% respectively. The corresponding inflation rates (Final) for Rural, Urban and Combined for **January, 2021** were 1.11%, 3.36% and 1.96% respectively.
4. The Index of Industrial Production (IIP) for the month of January, 2021 was released on 12<sup>th</sup> March, 2021 and it stands at 135.2.
5. More than 39.04 Crore surveys have been conducted under the ongoing 7th Economic Census (EC) across the country and information of more than 6.5 Crore establishments have been captured. During February, 2021, webinar / physical meetings with senior officials of 8 States / UT Governments were conducted for discussing Provisional results and Operational issues.
6. The highlights of Central Sector Projects costing Rs. 150 crores and above monitored under Online Computerized Monitoring System (OCMS) by this Ministry for the month of February, 2021 are as under:

7. As per the latest Review Report on the Performance of the Infrastructure Sectors up to the month of January 2021, Power Generation (**+2.16%**), Upgradation of Highways by State PWD & Border Road Organization (BRO) (**+38.79%**), Export Cargo handled at Airports (**+17.87%**) and Import Cargo handled at Airports (**+36.47%**) **exceeded** its targets.

8. The Sectors that fell short of their targets are Coal Production (**-19.74%**), Fertilizers Production (**-10.97%**), Crude Oil Production (**-5.54%**), Refinery Production (**-13.21%**), Natural Gas Production (**-14.05%**), Upgradation of Highways by NHAI (**-27.22%**), Railways (**-4.85%**), Passenger traffic handled at International terminal of the Airports (**-58.12%**) and Passenger Traffic handled at Domestic terminal of the Airports (**-41.31%**).
