



## Major initiatives and achievements of the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation during November 2018

On the Statistics side, the Ministry has released monthly Index of Industrial Production (IIP), the Consumer Price Index (CPI) and the estimates of Gross Domestic Product (GDP) for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter (July-September) of 2018-19 on 30<sup>th</sup> November 2018. The salient features of these are:

- As per the Quick Estimates (QE) of Index of Industrial Production (IIP) with base year 2011-12 released on 12<sup>th</sup> November 2018, the general index for the month of September 2018 stood at 128.6, which is 4.5 % higher as compared to the level in the corresponding month of previous year.
- The General Consumer Price Indices (CPI) with base year 2012 for the month of October 2018 (provisional) for Rural, Urban and Combined showed an annual inflation rate of 2.82%, 3.97% and 3.31% respectively. The Consumer Food Price Indices (CFPI) for October 2018 (provisional) for Rural, Urban and Combined showed an annual inflation rate of -0.57%, -1.15% and -0.86% respectively.
- The Central Statistics Office (CSO), Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation has released the Back-Series 2004-05 to 2011-12, Base 2011-12 on National Account Statistics on 28<sup>th</sup> November 2018.

2. Our monitoring of the infrastructure sector highlighted the following:

- As per the latest Flash Report for the ongoing Central Sector Projects costing ₹150 crore and above of September 2018:

- As per the latest Review Report on the Performance of the Infrastructure Sectors for the month of September 2018, Power Generation (+11.54%), Refinery Production (+2.09%), Goods traffic carried by Railways (+0.60%) and Passenger traffic handled at Domestic terminal of the Airports (+2.72%) exceeded their targets.
- The Sectors that fell short of their targets are Coal Production (-7.44%), Fertilizers Production (-14.63%), Crude Oil Production (-4.05%), Natural Gas Production (-7.74%), Upgradation of Highways by NHAI (-11.84%), Upgradation of Highways by State PWD & Border Road Organisation (BRO) (-20.41%), Export Cargo handled at Airports (-12.19%) and Import Cargo handled at Airports (-5.70%) and Passenger traffic handled at International terminal of the Airports (-2.27%).

3. Under MPLADS, an amount of ₹ 185.00 crore have been released during the Month of **November 2018** and the total fund released during the financial year 2018-19 up to **30<sup>th</sup> November 2018** is ₹ **2705.00** crore.

4. Status report on Minimum Government, Maximum Governance:

A new integrated MPLADS portal, developed on state-of-the-art Microsoft technology platform with built-in security features is in operation. This new portal provides single point of reference for all stakeholders including Members of Parliament and District Authorities. All MPLADS funds releases are being made only through PFMS & information about release of funds is uploaded on the website. The Ministry is regularly organizing training programmes for the district officials on the new website.
