## Major initiatives and achievements of the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation during June, 2022

The National Statistical Office (NSO) released Price Movement of Sub-Groups / Groups of Consumer Price Index (CPI) on **Base 2012=100** for All India Rural, Urban, Combined for the month of **June, 2022** (Provisional) and for the month of **May, 2022** (Final) on 12<sup>th</sup> July, 2022. The General Consumer Price Indices (CPI) for the month of **June, 2022** (Provisional) for Rural, Urban and Combined were 173.6, 171.5 and 172.6, showing an annual inflation rate of 7.09%, 6.92% and 7.01% respectively. The corresponding inflation rates (Final) for Rural, Urban and Combined for **May, 2022** were 7.08%, 7.08% and 7.04% respectively.

2. All-India Consumer Food Price Index (CFPI) for the month of **June, 2022 (Provisional)** for Rural, Urban and Combined were 171.2, 178.7 and 173.8 respectively. All India year-on-year inflation rates for CFPI for the month of **June, 2022 (Provisional)** for Rural, Urban and Combined sector were 7.61%, 8.04% and 7.75% respectively. The corresponding inflation rates (Final) for Rural, Urban and Combined for **May, 2022** were 7.76%, 8.20% and 7.97% respectively.

3. The All-India Index of Industrial Production (IIP) for the month of **May 2022** (Quick Estimates) with the base year 2011-12 has been released on 12<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 and it stood at 137.7.

5. Following important activities were organized by the Ministry, as a part of the week-long celebration of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav (AKAM) during the week 27<sup>th</sup> June -3<sup>rd</sup> July, 2022):

- (i) A Quiz competition was organized at all those State Capitals where Regional Offices of Field Operation Division (FOD), NSO are situated;
- (ii) Half a day seminar was conducted on "Data for Sustainable Development: India's Environmental Accounts and its Role in Policy and Decision Making";
- (iii) Half a day event was conducted on role and contributions of MPLAD Scheme in development of durable community assets by way of a short **Live Play** (in Hindi), a

- (iv) "Statistics Day 2022" was also celebrated as part of commemoration of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav (AKAM) on the theme "Data for Sustainable Development";
- (v) A Seminar in hybrid mode was conducted on the theme "Journey of Official Statistics involving an audience mainly from academia/students.

6. The major highlights of Central Sector Projects monitored under Online Computerized Monitoring System (OCMS) by this Ministry for the month of **June 2022** are as under:

7. As per the latest Review Report on the Performance of the Infrastructure Sectors up to the month of May 2022, Power Generation (+15.12%), Crude Oil Production (+2.86%), Refinery Production (+3.81%) and Railways (+7.67%) **exceeded** its targets.

8. The Sectors that **fell short** of their targets are Coal Production (-6.16%) Fertilizers Production (-12.01%), Natural Gas Production (-5.46%), Upgradation of Highways by NHAI (-21.00%), Upgradation of Highways by State PWD & Border Road Organization (BRO) (-29.00%), Export Cargo handled at Airports (-11.46%) Import Cargo handled at Airports (-21.03%), Passenger traffic handled at International terminal of the Airports (-9.01%) and Passenger traffic handled at Domestic terminal of the Airports (-5.01%).
