## The Management Information System (MIS) for Monthly/Quarterly Progress Report

Twenty Point Programme (TPP) – 2006 originally consisted of 20 Points and 66 items. Out of 66 items, 20 items were monitored on monthly basis.

However, recently due to modification in some schemes, presently, 65 items are monitored under TPP-2006. Out of 65 items, 19 items (earlier 20) measured on 37 parameters are being monitored on quarterly basis during the period 2014-15, of which 22 parameters are monitored against the targets fixed at the beginning of financial year by the Central Nodal Ministries and State Governments (information in respect of 15 items is being collected from various States/ UTs and for remaining 4 items from the concerned Central Nodal Ministries). The Ministry prepares a quarterly Progress Report (QPR) on TPP-2006 covering information on 22 parameters .

The QPR provides information on the Annual Physical Targets, Cumulative targets and achievements for the period under report. In order to curtail the delay in receipt of information from the States and the Central Nodal Ministries, a Web Based MIS has been evolved by the Ministry. This system allows the states/central Nodal Ministries to directly input the information on the monitoring of TPP into the MIS. Most of the States and Central Nodal Ministries are using MIS. The information in respect of particular month is to be input by a particular date (which presently stands at 20th of succeeding month) after which the collected information is frozen. The QPR finalized is sent to the State/UT Governments and Nodal Ministries concerned for taking appropriate measures in the areas of concern where the schemes are observed to be not doing well.
