NOTIFICATION

G.S.R. _____. In exercise of the powers conferred by the
proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President
hereby makes the following rules regulating the recruitment
to certain General Central Service Class III posts in the
Industrial Statistics Wing, Central Statistical Organisation,
Calcutta, Cabinet Secretariat, namely:-

RULES

1. These rules may be called the General Central Service
(Class III Posts in the Industrial Statistics Wing, Central
Statistical Organisation, Calcutta, Cabinet Secretariat)
Recruitment Rules, 1959.
2. These rules shall apply to recruitment to the posts
specified in column 1 of the Schedule to these rules, and
the number, classification and the scale of pay of the
said posts shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the
said Schedule.
3. The age limits and the qualifications for
recruitment to the posts aforesaid, the method of
recruitment and other matters relating thereto shall be
as specified in columns 5 to 13 of the said Schedule.
