It generates data on various vital aspects of the registered factories for use in the estimation of National Income, studies of industrial structure and policy formulation. 10	Wholesale Price Index (WPI)	Inflation rate calculated on the basis of the movement of the Wholesale Price Index (WPI) is an important measure to monitor the dynamic movement of prices. Important monetary and fiscal policy changes are often linked to WPI movements. Similarly, the movement of WPI serves as an important determinant, in formulation of trade, fiscal and other economic policies by the Government of India.
