

**Twitter Poster Session of NCAVES India Forum 2021**  
**(January 14-28, 2021)**

The Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation is organizing NCAVES India Forum, 2021 in collaboration with several national and international organisations including the United Nations Statistics Division (UNSD), European Union and UN Environment. The main objective of the National Forum would be to publicize efforts made in India for “Natural Capital Accounting”, with a specific focus on the implementation of the UN-prescribed System of Environmental Economic Accounting (SEEA) framework in the context of ecosystems.

A ‘twitter’ poster session will be held concurrent with the Forum, during January 14-28, 2021, where posters of selected research papers will be posted on the twitter handle of the event and that of the Ministry.

Areas of interest include, but are not limited to:

1. Defining ecosystem typologies for India for compiling SEEA based accounts;
2. Assessment of ecosystem extent and condition through SEEA based accounts;
3. Use of biophysical modelling techniques for estimating flows of ecosystem services;
4. Valuation of Ecosystem services using exchange value methods; and
5. Links of SEEA accounts to other frameworks – SNA, Post 2020 biodiversity framework, Sendai framework, UNFCCC, UNCCD and frameworks adopted by other multi-lateral environment agreements.

General Guidelines for the authors:

1. The research should be based on India or any of the developing countries in the South Asia region.
2. Posters can be based on recent published work (published in 2018 or later) or accepted for publication or on unpublished work.
3. For published papers, link should be provided to the original publication and details - like the venue/journal in which the paper was published (or accepted for publication) and the date of publication/acceptance - should be mentioned. For unpublished papers, link should be provided to the paper or a pdf version of the paper should be uploaded.
4. Papers published in Scopus Indexed Journals and cross-country studies will be preferred.
5. Posters are non-archival. They will not appear in the proceedings, and so authors are free to submit already-published work as well as submit accepted posters elsewhere.
6. Poster submissions will be reviewed mainly for adherence to the SEEA framework, relevance to the Forum and novelty to the audience.
7. Posters should be emailed to [dir2.ssdiv@mospi.gov.in](mailto:dir2.ssdiv@mospi.gov.in) by November 15, 2020 and poster acceptance will be confirmed by December 1, 2020.

## Presentation:

1. All posters will be posted on the Ministry's and the event's twitter handle.
2. The poster will be posted as a 4/6-slide PDF/GIF.
3. It should be shared in form of Powerpoint Presentation having not more than 6 slides. The important items/ parameters which can be shared in the presentation are given at Annexure-1. The author may arrange the sequencing and add/delete items/ parameters as per his/her convenience but the number of slides in the presentation should not be more than 6.
4. The poster should be designed in compact form providing all important information about the study.
5. Font type and size should be chosen in such a manner that it should be legible in running mode.
6. Poster should necessarily be accompanied with a copy of the complete Research Paper in PDF format.
7. Poster can also be accompanied by a recorded short (1-2 minute) lightning presentation.
8. Authors are encouraged to add links to a longer version of the talk and/or the written paper.
