Economic Census gives the total count of establishments in the formal and informal sector and number of workers working therein. The 7th EC proposes to extensively make use of technology for geographically mapping the establishments at the lowest levels so that it becomes useful for local level planning. As an integral part of this Census, a dynamic National Business Register (NBR) is proposed to be put in place to provide information on number of workers, turnover etc. for better economic planning. A draft vision document for conduct of the Census is enclosed for perusal and comments.

2. The conduct of Economic Census across the entire country is an enormous task which requires the cooperation and support of both the central and state governments. I invite suggestions on the vision document along with any State-specific requirements that can be met through the Census exercise. This Ministry is organizing a one day consultation workshop at Hall No. 5, Vigyan Bhawan on 2nd November 2018 for detailed discussions with States/ UTs and central Ministries/ Departments on the various aspects of conduct of the Census.
