Subject: Request for nomination -"12 Weeks Online Course of Machine Learning using Python": reg.

With the approval of the competent authority Cohort Based Training Programme (CBTP) has been introduced from current Financial Year (2020-21). This programme has two components: a) Twelve weeks Online Course of Machine Learning using Python and b) Foundation Course of Two Weeks on Artificial Intelligence, Big Data, and Block Chain etc. CBTP is part of MCTP first phase which is mandatory for the officers, up to JAG level officers (ISS officers of 8-10 years of service). These two components are to be completed in sequence. Therefore, officers (falling in this category) nominated by NSSTA for CBTP have to complete both the components sequentially. It is further informed that the first component of CBTP that is a twelve-weeks 'Online Course on Machine Learning using Python' is open for all in-service Indian Statistical Service (ISS) and Subordinate Statistical Service (SSS) officers.

- 2. Accordingly, the National Statistical Systems Training Academy (NSSTA), Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation (MoSPI) is organizing a twelveweeks 'Online Course of Machine Learning using Python' in collaboration with IIT-Madras for in-service ISS and SSS officers.
- 3. NSSTA would pay the fee for each candidate. After completion of the course, the candidates would have to submit a copy of the certificate of successfully completion of said course to NSSTA. If a candidate is unable to qualify the course in first attempt, s(he) would be given two additional attempts and the applicable examination fee would be paid by NSSTA. If a candidate is unable to qualify even after three attempts, then s(he) would have to bear the cost of the applicable examination fee her/himself in subsequent attempts.
- 4. In this context, it is requested that the willing ISS/SSS officers submit their nominations, mentioning the details of his/her Name, Designation, Place of posting, e-Mail Id and Mobile No., after obtaining requisite approval from their respective Controlling Authority by 20th September, 2020 to the undersigned at e-mail Id: ankur.kumar93@gov.in.
