(1) The first General Electon in the country was held from October, 1951 to March, 1952. At that time, there were three types of constituencies,single member, two member and three member. Number of votes polled are not available for General Election 1952, and as such number of valid votes have indicated in Column 4.
(2) In the second General Election, there were two types of constituencies-single member and two member.
(3) In the third and subsequent General Elections, all constituencies are single member.
(4) Excluding one seat for North East Frontier Tract filled by nomination.
(5) Out of 542 seats only 527 seats were filled. Poll was not held in 12 constituencies in Assam, 1 constituency each of Meghalaya, Ladakh ( J \& K) and Mandi ( Himachal Pradesh).
(6) Out of 543 seat, only 529 seats were filled in. These are inclusive of one uncontested return from Srinagar in Jammu and Kashmir and four countermanded polls one each from Goa, Madhya Pradesh, Tamil Nadu and West Bengal / Elections were not held in the entire State of Assam (14 seats).
(7) Out of 543 seats, only 521 seats were filled in. Elections were not held in the entire State of Jammu and Kashmir ( 6 seats), Punjab (13 seats) ,Uttar Pradesh(1seat) and Bihar (2seats).
