

## 25. TRADE UNIONS

### Table 25.1 to 25.4

Figures given in this section are based on the annual returns relating to calendar years received from the State Governments and Union Territories under the Indian Trade Unions Act, 1926. The Act applies to the entire Indian Union. The figures do not include Lakshadweep.

The statistics relate to only those unions which have been registered under the Act. It is not obligatory on trade unions to secure registration under the Indian Trade Unions Act. Even among registered ones, the response of the unions submitting annual returns is generally less than fifty percent. Data regarding unregistered unions are not available.

**INCOME AND EXPENDITURE OF REGISTERED TRADE UNIONS**

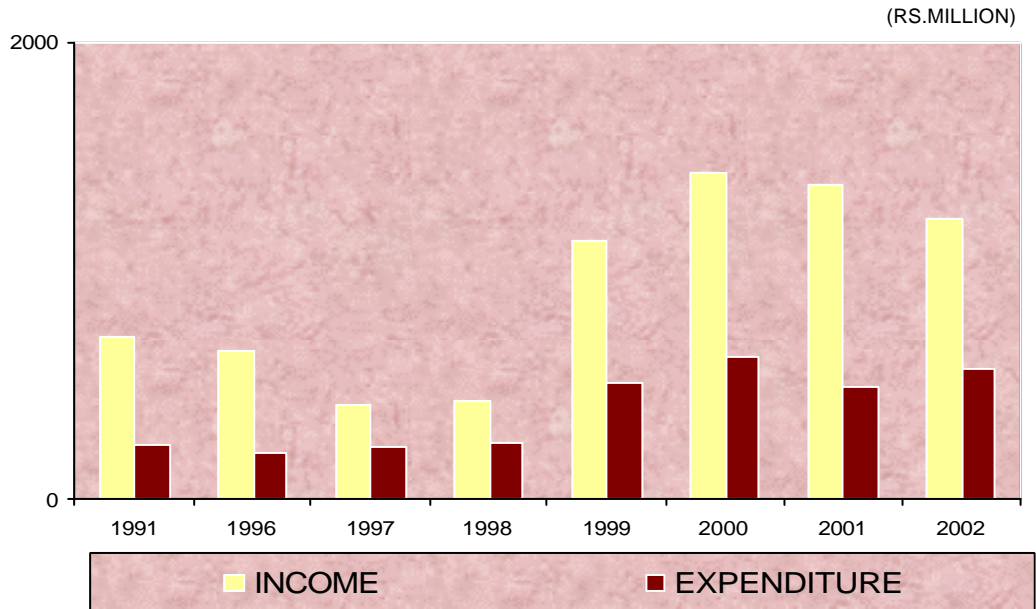
