ORDER

Subject: Grant of Assured Career Progression (ACP) to SI Grade II of SSS - Regarding.

In pursuance, of DOP&T's OM No. 35034 / 1 / 97 – Estt. (D) dated 9th August 1999 and guidelines to regularize ACP in SSS on the consideration of recommendation of Special Departmental Anomaly Committee issued vide OM No. 11024 / 14 / 2006 – SSS dated 13th May 2011, 15th July 2011 and 15th September 2011 and on the recommendation of the Screening Committee, meeting of which was held on 28th January 2013, the Competent Authority has approved grant of 1st ACP in the pay scale of Rs. 5500 - 9000, on personal basis to Statistical Investigator Grade II who was in the pay scale of Rs. 5000 – 8000 of Subordinate Statistical Service (SSS) and was eligible for 1st ACP on completion of 12 years of regular service between 12.02.2002 to 31.08.2008 as per details given below:

Incumbents of SSS eligible for 1st ACP in the pay scale of Rs. 5500 - 9000 after Notification of SSS.

2. The officer is entitled for fixation of pay as per the provisions of CCS (Revised Pay) Rules, 1997 and the ACP guidelines.
3. The Participating Ministries / Department / Organization of SSS are requested to fix the pay under higher Pay Scale after due verification of eligibility condition of ACP from the service records of the officers.
4. The Participating Ministries / Department / Organization of SSS are requested to see that officer placed in the higher Pay Scale under ACP, was not under suspension or no charge sheet was issued or no disciplinary proceeding or prosecution case for criminal charge was pending against him on the crucial date.
5. The officer, if any, who is under currency of penalty, will be placed in the next higher Pay as per ACP Scheme only on expiry of that period.



6. Those incumbents of SSS have earned 1st or 2nd ACP in two grade structure on or after 01.01.2006 in that case fixation benefits under 2nd MACP or 3rd MACP in Grade Pay of Rs. 4600 would require to be extended i.e. their date of 2nd ACP after 01.01.2006. However, GP of Rs. 4800 granted under 3rd MACP will remain unchanged.

7. The incumbents granted 1st or 2nd ACP between the period of **01.01.2006 to 31.08.2008** would be governed under the provision of sub-para 3 (A) of DOP&T OM No. 35034 / 3 / 2008 – Estt. (D) Dated 9th September 2010

8. MACP benefits extended under 2nd 3rd MACP on completion of 10, 20 and 30 years of regular service as on 01.09.2008 and thereafter will remain unchanged.

9. The Participating Ministries / Department / Organization of SSS is requested to provide copy of this order to all concerned incumbents and place a copy of the same in service book of officials..




