Sub: Implementation of 6th Pay Commission Notification in respect of Subordinate Statistical Service – Regarding.

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Ministry OM of even No. dated 5th September 2008 vide which it has been decided to implement 6th CPC recommendations in respect of SSS officials posted in different participating Ministries of SSS. In this regard it has been noticed that some of the participating ministries of SSS have fixed the pay of SI Grade-II of SSS by granting them the higher Grade pay of Rs. 4600 and in some cases Grade Pay of Rs. 4800 has been given on the basis of ACP granted in pre-revised scales. However, since the pre-revised scales of Rs. 5000 -8000 and Rs. 5500- 9000 were merged & upgraded while implementing 6th CPC recommendations & the MACP guidelines provide for ignoring past promotions / upgradations, giving higher grade of pay to SIs is not proper. In view of this and to maintain uniformity in the matter of pay fixation as on 1.1.2006, all participating Ministries / Department / Organisation of SSS are requested to review the pay fixation benefits and fix the pay of all Statistical Investigator Grade I by granting Grade Pay of Rs. 4600 as on 1.1.2006 and to fix the pay of all Statistical Investigator Grade II by granting Grade Pay of Rs. 4200 as on 1.1.2006 by ignoring their earlier ACP benefits.

However, the matter is being taken up with DOP&T for clarification regarding Grade pay on the basis of ACP granted earlier and further communication will follow.

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Ministry OM of even No. dated 5th September 2008 vide which it has been decided to implement 6th CPC recommendations in respect of SSS officials posted in different participating Ministries of SSS. In this regard it has been noticed that some of the participating ministries of SSS have fixed the pay of SI Grade-II of SSS by granting them the higher Grade pay of Rs. 4600 and in some cases Grade Pay of Rs. 4800 has been given on the basis of ACP granted in pre-revised scales. However, since the pre-revised scales of Rs. 5000 -8000 and Rs. 5500- 9000 were merged & upgraded while implementing 6th CPC recommendations & the M/ACP guidelines provide for ignoring past promotions / upgradations, giving higher grade of pay to SIs is not proper. The undersigned is directed to refer to this Ministry OM of even No. dated 5th September 2008 vide which it has been decided to implement 6th CPC recommendations in respect of SSS officials posted in different participating Ministries of SSS. In this regard it has been noticed that some of the participating ministries of SSS have fixed the pay of SI Grade-II of SSS by granting them the higher Grade pay of Rs. 4600 and in some cases Grade Pay of Rs. 4800 has been given on the basis of ACP granted in pre-revised scales. However, since the pre-revised scales of Rs. 5000-8000 and Rs. 5500-9000 were merged & upgraded while implementing 6th CPC recommendations & the MACIP guidelines provide for ignoring past promotions / upgradations, giving higher grade of pay to SIs is not proper. In view of this and to maintain uniformity in the matter of pay fixation as on 1.1.2006, all participating Ministries / Department / Organisation of SSS are requested to review the pay fixation benefits and fix the pay of all Statistical Investigator Grade I by granting Grade Pay of Rs. 4600 as on 1.1.2006 and to fix the pay of all Statistical Investigator Grade II by granting Grade Pay of Rs. 4200 as on 1.1.2006 by ignoring their earlier ACP benefits.

However, the matter is being taken up with DOP&T for clarification regarding Grade pay on the basis of ACP granted earlier and further communication will follow.

The Participating Ministries / Department / Organization of SSS are requested to see that officer placed in the higher Pay Scale under ACP, was not under suspension or no charge sheet was issued or no disciplinary proceeding or prosecution case for criminal charge was pending against him on the crucial date.

5. The officer, if any, who is under currency of penalty, will be placed in the next higher Pay as per ACP Scheme only on expiry of that period.

6. Those incumbents of SSS, who have earned 2nd ACP in two grade structure on or after 01.01.2006 in that case fixation under 1st MACP or 2nd MACP in Grade Pay of Rs. 4600 may be pre-poned from the date on which 2nd ACP have been granted after 01.01.2006. However, date and Grade Pay granted under 2nd MACP will remain unchanged.

7. The incumbents granted 2nd ACP between the period of **01.01.2006 to 31.08.2008** would be governed under the provision of sub-para 3 (A) of DOP&T OM No. 35034 / 3 / 2008 – Estt. (D) Dated 9th September 2010
